Alexis Krasilovsky nació en Alaska, sobrevivió a una agresión sexual a punta de pistola, sabe lo que es estar completamente sordo, recorrió el país en autostop con una chaqueta de la Solidaridad de las Panteras Negras y viajó por más de veinte países. Tras graduarse en Yale y recibir un máster en Bellas Artes en CalArts, Krasilovsky se convirtió en una cineasta galardonada, con dos largometrajes documentales mundiales y otras películas, además de hologramas. Es autora de "Great Adaptations: Screenwriting and Global Storytelling" (- Ganadora del 2º Premio Internacional de Escritores 2019) y "Watermelon Lin-

guistics: New and Selected Poems" (finalista, 2022 International Book Awards). Su película poética de 2021, "The Parking Lot of Dreams", un híbrido entre poesía pandémica y fotocollages, se ha proyectado en más de una docena de festivales de todo el mundo. Alexis Krasilovsky was born in Alaska, survived sexual assault at gunpoint, knows what it's like to be completely deaf, hitchhiked cross-country in a Black Panther Solidarity jacket, and traveled to over twenty countries. After graduation from Yale and receiving an MFA at CalArts, Krasilovsky became an award-winning filmmaker, with

two global documentary features and other films as well as holograms. She is the author of "Great Adaptations: Screenwriting and Global Storytelling" (- 2nd Place Winner, 2019 International Writers Awards) and "Watermelon Linguistics: New and Selected Poems," (finalist, 2022 International Book Awards). Her 2021 poetry film, "The Parking Lot of Dreams," a hybrid between pandemic poetry and photocollages, has screened in over a dozen festivals worldwide. See www.alexiskrasilovsky.com for more.
